# Western Ontario: Around Georgian Bay

## Highlights

### Toronto

Toronto is a truly cosmopolitan city with much to engage all visitors, from the dominant CN Tower to side-walk cafes.

### Windsor

Downtown has lively bars and riverside walkway. The surrounding region is very rural including several vineyards.

### Georgian Bay

The blue waters of Georgian Bay are dotted with thousands of islands and inlets.

### Agawa Canyon Rail Tour

Scenic all-day rail journey north of Sault Ste Marie through dense forests and over ravines to the spectacular Agawa Canyon.

### Manatoulin Island 1st Nation/ Aboriginal Heritage

The world's largest freshwater island in Lake Huron. 1st Nations attractions and tours.

### Point Pelee

The most southerly point of mainland Canada, a mecca for migratory birds in spring and autumn and with an array of habitat.

Head west from Toronto to the north shore of Lake Erie where there is a string of small ports and country towns as well as long sandy beaches. Continue on to Windsor via Point Pelee and then follow the coast of Lake Huron to Goderich a charming little town over looking the Lake. Then drive up the Bruce Peninsula dividing Georgian Bay from Lake Huron to Tobermory. Cross on the Chi Cheeman ferry to Manitoulin Island and on to Little Current. The route then continues west to Sault Ste Marie, from where you can explore the north shore of Lake Superior or the wilderness surrounding the town. Retrace the route east and continue around Georgian Bay to Parry Sound, tucked away on an inlet among 30,000 Islands. Return south to Toronto before returning home.

## Highlights

### 1,000 Islands & St Lawrence River

From Kingston to the waterside towns of Gananoque and Brockville, this stretch of the St Lawrence is full of charm and beauty.

### Ottawa

Canada's Capital on the banks of the Ottawa and Rideau Rivers, with its mix of English and French influences.

### Rideau Canal

Originally built as a defensive barrier, recently becoming a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stretching from Kingston to Ottawa with 47 locks.

### Algonquin National Park

3,000 sq miles of wilderness. Wildlife abounds with plenty of opportunities for hiking canoeing and outdoor activities.

### Niagara Falls

One of the worlds great and iconic sights, stunning close-up views of the water crashing over the 188ft fall from above or on the Maid of the Mist below.

Following time in Toronto drive along the northern shore of Lake Ontario to the 1,000 Islands region and the pretty town of Gananoque. Explore this fascinating area including the Rideau Canal either from the land or from the water. On to Ottawa, Canada's Capital, with its National Museums and Galleries. Heading west from Ottawa to Algonquin Provincial Park and Huntsville, an area renowned for forests, lakes and spectacular scenery. There are numerous opportunities for outdoor activities. Travel south to Niagara-On-The-Lake, a town of leafy Victorian streets where the Niagara river flows into Lake Ontario and near to thundering Niagara Falls. Return east to Toronto and home.
