Highlights

Redding

Nestled in the northern reaches of the Sacramento Valley the City serves as the gateway to the surrounding wilderness. With museums, restaurants etc including the Sundial Bridge.

Redwood National Park and Jedediah Smith Redwoods State Park

Over 200 miles of trails include Lady Bird Johnson Grove, Tall Trees Grove and Fern Canyon Trail.

Avenue of the Giants

33-mile drive through magnificent forest, along Highway 101 south of Eureka.

Mendocino

Picturesque small town with wonderful coastal scenery.

Sonoma Coast State Beaches

Miles of coastal drives, sea stacks, natural arches, small coves and wonderful beach-combing.



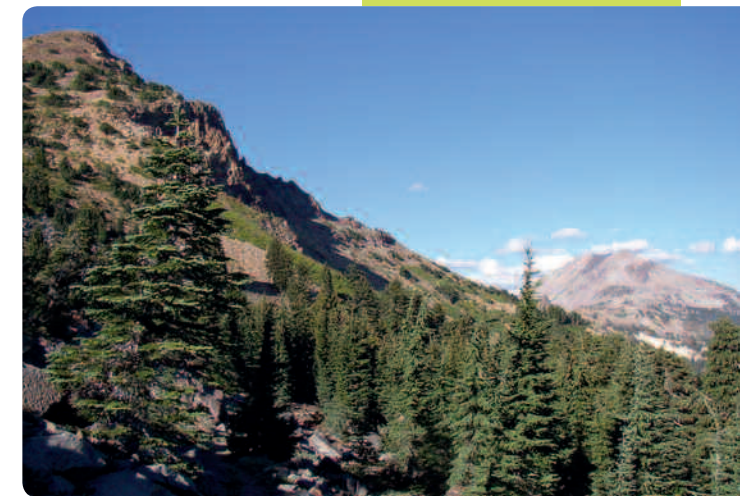
Explore the historic districts of the state capital, Sacramento. Journey through Sacramento Valley to Redding, in the beautiful Shasta region surrounded by the California Cascades, spectacular Mt Shasta and the Trinity Alps. Cross into Klamath County, home to the incredibly blue waters of Crater Lake National Park. Head to Grants Pass in the heart of Rogue Valley, see some of the world's largest trees in Redwood National Park and drive the 'Avenue of the Giants'. Travel along Highway 101 to Trinidad. Spectacular ocean views and charming villages dot the coast to Mendocino. Taste fine wines in the wooded valleys of Sonoma. Journey back to the Golden Gate city of San Francisco.

Journey into Gold Country and visit charming towns dotted along the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains, such as Sutter Creek with its rich history and small town hospitality, Amador City where time past has been preserved and Placerville with its historic architecture. Explore Yosemite National Park, with waterfalls, meadows and woodlands making this one of the most beautiful places on earth. Head into Lassen Volcanic National Park and discover its turbulent and fiery past, including steam vents, mudpots, boiling pools and volcanic peaks. Head north and skirt the Pacific Crest National Scenic Trail to Mt Shasta and into the Sacramento Valley before heading back into San Francisco.

Highlights

Yosemite National Park

Mariposa Grove with giant Sequoias, Tuolumne Meadows massive granite domes; Yosemite Valley; Glacier Point look out over Vernal Falls. Over 700 miles of hiking trails.

Sutter Creek

A charming town with beautiful 19th century buildings in pristine condition.

Lassen Volcanic National Park

Walk to the boiling mudpots of Bumpass Hell; take the scenic Park Drive.

Mount Shasta and Trinity Alps

Towering mountains, scenic drives including Highway 3, Trinity Heritage Scenic Byway; mineral springs and pools.
