

Highlights

Death Valley

Set between the Black and Panamint ranges – roadside services are miles apart, carry lots of water.

Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks

General Sherman Tree in Sequoia Park, is the largest living thing on earth. Pride of Kings Canyon Park is General Grant Grove, a forest of giants over 2000 years old.

Yosemite National Park

The park's main attractions lie within the narrow 7-mile Yosemite Valley, bounded by colossal granite formations – Half Dome, El Captain, Cathedral Rock and Clouds Rest. With waterfalls cascading over rocks into the valley far below, and meadows, woodlands and the crystal clear River Merced, this is one of the most beautiful places on earth.

Death Valley, Sequoia, Kings Canyon and Yosemite

Depart from Las Vegas, one of the most dynamic cities on earth, west to Death Valley, USA's most famous desert and the lowest point in North America. Enjoy two of California's finest National Parks – Kings Canyon and Sequoia with 14,000ft peaks, alpine lakes and stately groves of Sequoia. Further north is Yosemite, quieter in the off season and arguably even more beautiful. From here head west to San Francisco and the Golden Gate.



