The heart of the West and the high point of the Rockies

From Denver, the Mile High City, to stunning mountain scenery, Colorado offers some real *highlights*.

Round the Rockies

Highlights

Colorado Springs

Visit the Garden of the Gods, considered to be the Most Beautiful City Park in the USA and walk along the huge red rocks with Pikes Peak as a background. Take the Manitou Springs Cog Railway to the top of Pikes Peak, at 14,000ft+ the highest railway in North America.

Great Sand Dunes National Park

Over 30 square miles of dunes rising to over 750ft and shaped by the winds through the San Luis Valley.

Crested Butte

Historic 1880s mining town surrounded by towering peaks, full of Old West charm and more fine restaurants per capita than any other town in the US.

Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park

Unique and spectacular landscape, no other canyon in North America combines the narrow opening and startling depths.

Drives

Trail Ridge Road/ Beaver Creek Road

The highest continuous highway in US, (12,183ft) traversing Rocky Mountain National Park from Estes Park to Grand Lake.

Silver Thread Scenic Byway

A 75 mile drive between Lake City and South Fork, with natural beauty and wonders plus historic gold and silver mines from the boomtown era.

Top of The Rockies Scenic Byway


Designated as one of only 53 roads in USA as a National Scenic Byway, 75 mile stretch of highway seldom dropping below 9,000ft. Cross the Continental Divide by driving the length of the Byway.

From the Mile High City head north west along the Peak to Peak Scenic and Historic Byway to Estes Park. From here you can explore Rocky Mountain National Park. Head south for a magnificent drive to Glenwood Springs, past Colorado's best known ski resorts, continue south to Gunnison along the Top of the Rockies Scenic Byway. Gunnison is an old mining town at heart.

South-east from Gunnison is Alamosa near to the Great Sand Dune National Park, a real curiosity in a land of 14,000 ft peaks. Head back North East through old gold towns to Manitou Springs, from here you can catch the train to the top of Pikes Peak the most renowned of Colorado's 25 fourteeners, or explore The Garden of the Gods a wonderful 'city' park close by in Colorado Springs. Denver International Airport is about a two hour drive for your return or onward flight.

You can spend many days in Denver, 'The Mile High City' exploring the diversity of attractions, museums, art galleries, restaurants, parks and endless shopping. Visit the lobby of the historic Brown Palace Hotel and sample water from their own spring!

Rocky Mountain National Park

Encapsulating everything that makes the Rockies special. Rugged peaks, alpine streams, high altitude glaciers and dense forests.

Drives

Peak to Peak Scenic Byway

Running along the Front Range with spectacular views over the continental divide, through forests and a historic mining area.

Mount Evans Scenic Byway

Reaching an altitude of 14,264ft, the upper section of this road is the highest paved highway in North America. At the summit you'll enjoy the big picture – the entire Front Range and Continental Divide sprawls at your feet.

Guanella Pass Road

An Old wagon trail used by miners between Georgetown and Grant, 50 miles west of Denver passing through a variety of environments.

Welcome to Denver – the Mile High City – where 300 days of sunshine, a thriving arts and cultural scene, diverse neighbourhoods, and the Rocky Mountain backdrop combine for the world's most spectacular playground. Denver offers stunning architecture, award-winning dining and unparalleled views, all within walking distance from its famed 16th Street pedestrian mall. A free shuttle carries visitors up and down this central corridor, providing quick access to world-class art and culture, wine bars, restaurants, and live music hot spots in Larimer Square or historic LoDo. Upscale shopping awaits at Cherry Creek, while Denver's seven professional sports teams showcase this city's active spirit. Experience what the locals know.

After your time in the city why not hire a car and in just over an hour you could be amongst the peaks and iconic landscapes of Rocky Mountain National Park, one of the most scenic areas in North America, nearby is Estes Park with its shops, restaurants and the inspiration for Stephen King's book 'The Shining' or 90 miles west over high mountain passes to Colorado's famous winter resorts.

Day 1

Arrive in Denver with time to take in the nightlife and restaurants

Day 2

Explore downtown Denver including 16th St Mall, The Colorado State Capital, Denver Art Museum and more

Hire a car and drive to The Rocky National Park about 75 miles north west of Denver

Day 4

Head west into the Rockies and follow Scenic Byways over mountain passes, visit some of Colorado's famous winter resorts such as Breckenridge.
