# New Mexico's Enchanted North

Arrive in Albuquerque, city of contrasts, rich in culture and heritage and bathed in sunshine 351 days a year. Collect your car and drive the Turquoise Trail to Santa Fe, the oldest state capital in the country and surrounded by millions of acres of National Forest. Take the High Road to Taos past Spanish style churches and chapels before heading west to historic Chama. Surprisingly green, Chama is home to two lakes and stunning mountain vistas.

Your journey continues to Farmington from where you can view the nearby Aztec ruins then veer south to Gallup, the epicentre for Native American culture. Tour the many ghost towns and abandoned pueblos before heading back to Albuquerque.

# New Mexico's Scenic South

Fly into Albuquerque and enjoy exploring the Old Town and Plaza. Pass the beautiful scenery and Spanish architecture to Taos, home to the Taos Pueblo. After an overnight in Mountainair head south to Ruidoso surrounded by the cool pines of Lincoln National Forest. Your drive continues via Roswell to Carlsbad from where you can visit Carlsbad Caverns National Park.

Travel through the stunning scenery of Lincoln National Forest and the Organ Mountain Range towards Las Cruces nestled between the Rio Grande and Chihuahua Desert. Stay overnight in Silver City, gateway to Gila National Forest before returning to Albuquerque for your flight home.
