Stretching from Albany to the Canadian boarder surrounded by the Adirondack Mountains.



Contrast that with some quiet time on Presque Isle and in Erie. Stand in awe of the transformation of Pittsburgh, America's steel city into a great contemporary travel destination. In Gettysburg, you'll stay right on the battlefield, with its timeless story. Follow an Amish buggy down a winding country road amongst the quaint pristine fields where the timeless lives of the Amish never change. Fly home with great memories.

Introduce yourself to the Big Apple in style at the New York Helmsley before you meander the Hudson River's majestic palisades with mansions perched on every cliff. After touring the only French-influenced state house in the nation, two nights in the Adirondacks allow you to enjoy the natural beauty of six million acres of preserved lush, dense forest punctuated with cobalt lakes. You'll stay on the shore of the St Lawrence River at Alexandria Bay in the stunning 1000 Islands region, and enjoy the Seaway Trail. Turn West to the Finger Lakes region, and one of the State's many Wine Trails. After Corning, Harrisburg is close enough to Gettysburg to catch a glimpse of the battlefield before ending your trip with a stay in the historic Bucks County town of New Hope.
