Highlights

Portland

Surrounded by natural beauty, known for its distinctive neighbourhoods, beautiful gardens, craft beer, indie music scene, great shopping and much more.

Crater Lake National Park

Take the 33 mile Rim Drive around the deepest lake in USA.

Astoria

This one-time centre of seafaring boasts the kind of scruffy charm that draws in painters and writers.

Pacific Coast Highway

Oregon's 362 mile coastline is one of nature's masterworks. An awe-inspiring drive.

McKenzie Pass - Santiam Pass Scenic Byway

Experience dramatic views of mountains mirrored in crystal-clear lakes, and beautiful waterfalls, including Sahalie and Koosah Falls.

Follow the south bank of the Columbia River to the Pacific and Astoria, the oldest US settlement in the American West. The drive south along the Pacific Coastal Highway is one of the most spectacular in the USA. Past Cannon Beach with its iconic basalt sea stacks and through the towns of Newport and Yachats, the coast here is moulded by ancient volcanic activity. South of Florence giant sand dunes dominate the drive for 50 miles, followed by beaches flanked with high cliffs. Brookings, just north of the California border, boasts palm trees and azaleas as well as the giant Redwoods. From here loop back north to Bend via Crater Lake and the Cascade Lakes Scenic Byway. The drive ends with time in Portland - 'The City of Roses'.

From Portland drive the short distance to the farming community of Carlton in the heart of Oregon Wine Country. Continue west to the Pacific Ocean and head south to Florence along the spectacular coast road. From the coast turn east through the Willamette Valley and on to the up and coming town of Bend. Continue east past the John Day Fossil Beds National Monument, through the diverse Blue Mountains with its beautiful scenery and the Elkhorn Scenic Byway to Baker City. Explore Hells Canyon where the gorge walls tower up to 8,000ft above the Snake River. Return west via Pendleton, the largest town in eastern Oregon and along the Columbia River Gorge to Portland.

Bend
