Glacier National Park

The 'Crown of the North American Continent' a place of natural beauty and majesty.

Snake River – Hell's Canyon

Going to the Sun Road

Beartooth Scenic Byway

One of the most spectacular National Forest routes on the continent.

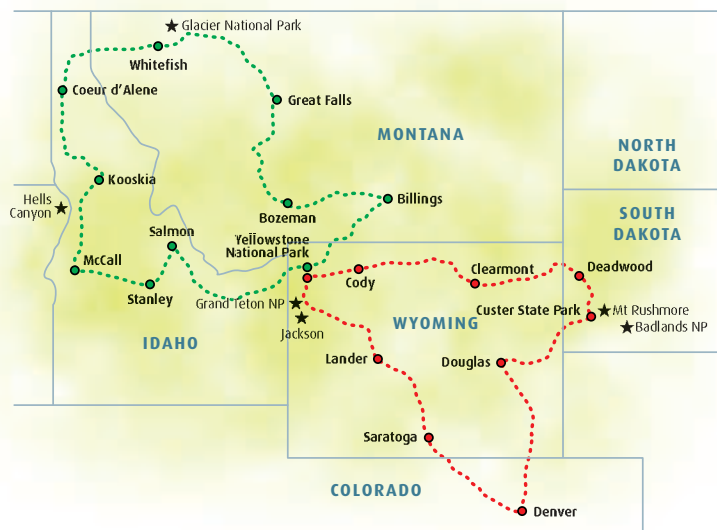
Payette River Scenic Byway

Follows an exceedingly picturesque mountain valley dotted with resort towns.

Arrive in Billings, Montana, known as Big Sky Country because of the dramatic views across the plains with mountain backdrops. Drive through Beartooth Country to Yellowstone, a testament to the raw power of the elements. Continue west into Idaho and the town of Salmon offering white water adventures. Follow the Salmon River Scenic Byway to Stanley and through the Sawtooth Range to the Payette River Valley. North to McCall and then on through the Idaho heartland and Indian Reservation of Nez Perce to Coeur d'Alene. Turn east and back into Montana again climbing into the Rocky Mountains at Whitefish. Follow Going to the Sun Road through Glacier National Park crossing the continental divide again. Head south through Charlie Russell Country crossing the Missouri River at Great Falls and along the Kings Hill National Scenic Byway to Bozeman. Return to Billings following the Yellowstone River.

Highlights

Yellowstone National Park

A domain of dense forests and velvety meadows which give way to yawning gorges and steaming wetlands.

Mt Rushmore Nat Monument

The four presidential faces carved with consummate craftsmanship gaze out from Mt Rushmore, each measuring over 60ft.

Grand Teton National Park

An ethereal mountain landscape where jagged peaks tower more than a mile above the Jackson Hole Valley.

Badlands National Park

A moonscape of tormented ridges, crumbly spires and precipitous canyons stretching as far as the eye can see.

The Black Hills

An island of contrasts, rising in stunning visual counterpoint to the surrounding prairies.

Peter Norbeck Scenic Byway

Through tunnels between towering spires and over 'pigtail' bridges.

From the gateway city of Denver head north via Douglas Wyoming to Custer State Park, South Dakota, with its Bison herds. Nearby are Mount Rushmore and Crazy Horse Memorial as well as the Badlands National Park. Follow the Peter Norbeck Scenic Byway and on through the Black Hills National Forest to Deadwood famous for many colourful characters now resting in Boot Hill cemetery. From the Black Hills travel via Spearfish Canyon Scenic Byway with its autumn colours rivalling anything in New England, west past the Devils Tower (featured in Close Encounters) to Clearmont. Follow the Big Horn Scenic Byway, through Cody Country, past Buffalo Bill State Park and on to Yellowstone National Park. From Yellowstone travel south parallel to the Grand Teton Range taking a detour to the western town of Jackson, and to Lander. Enjoy the hot springs at Saratoga before returning to Denver via the Snowy Range Scenic Byway.
