Experience Oregon with its fine wineries, spectacular scenery and stunning scenic drives. From Portland, City of Roses, drive the historic Columbia River Highway with some of Oregon's most magnificent scenery, the majestic Multnomah Falls and the charming Hood River Valley with its many wineries. Head into the North Willamette Valley Wine region to McMinnville located in Yamhill County known for its picturesque vineyards and long, moderate growing season. Drive the Cascades Lake Scenic Byway to Eugene, discovering thundering waterfalls, lush forests and into the South Willamette Valley Wine region containing over twenty of the state's wineries including some of the warmer climate varieties such as delicious Merlot, Marechal Foch, and Cabernet Franc. Head to the Pacific Coast to Gold Beach where the Rogue River meets the Pacific Ocean. The Pacific coast drive is one of the best in the USA. Relax before returning to Portland for your return flight home.

Leave Walla Walla Valley and head to the Cave B Winery at Quincy blessed with 300 days of sunshine annually and four distinct seasons. Head to Woodinville, nestled in the Sammamish River Valley, Western Washington's wine and culinary destination of choice and home to nearly two dozen wineries including the Columbia Winery, Silver Lake Winery and Chateau Ste. Michelle.
